- The correct use of our plant in will not put people, plant or the environment at risk.

It is our Company's policy to:

- Ensure our operators are licensed, competent and authorized to use the plant assigned to them without risk to others.
- Implement a control system to ensure all operator and plant licenses are legal, valid and renewed or regarded when required.
- Meet or exceed the applicable legal Road safety regulations and requirements.
- Select the operator most suited to safe operation of that specific plant.
- Put an effective monitoring system into place to ensure the plant is maintained and serviced and in safe working condition at all times.
- Prohibit the use plant that is unsuited to the task, damaged, un-roadworthy or will put people, plant or the environment at risk.
- Equip our plant in accordance with the necessary and applicable road and safety regulations and requirements.
- Promote compliance to the rules, signage and safety regulations on public and private roads.
- Provide safe transport for our employees when required.
- Inform our employees of identified hazards, consequences and control measures associated with the use of plant.
- Report and investigate all plant an road incidents in accordance with our incident management System and insurance requirements.

We are committed to:

- Protecting the health and safety of our employees and those who may be affected by the use of our plant on public or private property.
- Obeying and promoting the compliance to the Road safety act, private road safety regulations and applicable road signage and speed limits.
